

Sever shall be made to discharge  
at the point so affroued.

This ordinance shall take effect from  
and after March 1<sup>st</sup> 1907.

It is further ordered that publication  
be made of this ordinance in  
the Chapel Hill News for three months  
and by special notice to all person  
known to be affected thereby.

Another ordinance was adopted  
as follows:

No person shall dump or throw  
any paper or any other objectionable  
trash on any of the streets of the  
town of Chapel Hill.

Any person violating the above  
ordinance shall be fined one  
dollar for each offence.

On Motion it was ordered that the  
town wagon shall haul off such  
trash once a week, provided that  
it is kept in convenient receptacles.  
On Motion the following ordinance  
was adopted:

#+ That the speed of Automobiles in the  
corporate limits of Chapel Hill be  
limited to eight miles per hour,  
And that the drivers of Automobiles  
be required to keep to the extreme  
right side of the street when passing  
vehicles, the horse or horses to which  
show any signs of fright; and also  
slow up or stop.
