

The Treasurer shall renew his bond annually on the first day of June of each successive year, the amount of which bond shall be fixed and approved by the Board of Aldermen of the town of Chapel Hill, and shall be registered in the office of the register of deeds of Orange County; and the treasurer shall keep an account of the receipts and disbursements of the special tax money in a separate book to be kept for that purpose, and he shall annually publish a statement showing the balance and condition of the special tax funds in his hands.

Sec. 7.

That this act shall be in force from and after its ratification.

The Board then adjourned.
