The Board of Aldermen met in regular session, at the Mayor's office at 8 P.M.

Mayor Robinson presiding.

All members of Board present except Mr. Check.

Minutes of last meeting were read and approved.

On motion of Mr. Hendon the Chief of Police was ordered to buy of R.L. Stroud the Franklin Portin wagon at \$42.00, provided it is in good condition, if not to buy new one at \$75.00.

On motion of Mr. Zerkow the following bills were approved and ordered paid:

R.L. Stroud 18.21, Natl Enameling & Stamping Co. 8.88, The Wm. H. 7.23, Pomona Terra-cotta Co. 8.64.

The Finance Committee was directed to make a complete list of all who receive sanitary services and all sewer connectors and charge the same to the Tax Collector.

On motion of G.C. Pickard the Chief of Police was ordered to collect balance of dog tax <sup>by the authority of the Board</sup> for any dog he found for which the tax can not be collected immediately take possession of same and in due time put him to death.
