The Board met in the Mayor's office at 4 P.M. according to Adjournment. Mayor Roberson presiding.

All members of the Board present.

Minutes of last meeting read and approved.

On Motion of Mr. Hart the Automobile license tax Ordinance was changed so as to read: On each Automobile run for hire \$1.00.

On Motion of Mr. Embanks it was ordered that the ~~night~~ ~~police~~ office of Night Police be abolished.

On Motion of Mr. Embanks Dr. Key was allowed \$75.00 for fort pay of expense of special detective on account of the recent tragedy at his home.

The following Ordinances adopted offered by Mr. Embanks were unanimously adopted:

In addition to the cash balance, the Treasurer of the Sewer Fund has in his hands the draft of the Maryland Casualty Company for \$141.46.

While it is true we start the new fiscal year with a smaller cash balance than at the beginning of the last fiscal year, nevertheless, we feel that the above showing is an unusually good one for the Town of Chapel Hill in view of the fact that during the past year the town has purchased a street sprinkler at a cost of approximately \$250. and an extra town wagon at a cost of approximately \$45.00, has appropriated a special fund of \$100.00 for the use of the Tree Commission, and has spent approximately \$300. for sand to improve the condition of the main street, whose surface suffered so severely from the delay on the part of the contractors in the completion of the sewerage system, and the unusually hard winter just passed through.
