for him to resign as Mayor.
On Motion of Mr. Roberson his resigna-
tion was accepted.

On Motion of Mr. Roberson Dr. Roberson
was appointed to draft resolutions of
appreciation of the valuable
service Mayor McLendon has
rendered, and of regrets of his departure.

On Motion of Dr. Roberson Mr. Roberson
was elected Mayor and Mr. Check
Mayor Pro Tem.

On Motion of Dr. Roberson Clyde L. Evboms
was elected to fill the vacancy on
the Board caused by Mr. Roberson
being elected Mayor.
