AUTOMOBILE ORDINANCE AMENDMENT.

The ordinance against Automobiles standing on certain part of Franklin Street, was amended, on May 28th, to read as follows:

Be it ordained, that no Automobile shall be allowed to remain on the North side of Franklin Street between Henderson and Columbia Streets, nor in front of any business houses on the South side of said section, longer than thirty (30) minutes.

Any one violating this ordinance shall be fined five (\$5.00) dollars.

This ordinance shall be in full force on and after Mapy 28th, 1914.
