On Motion of Mr. Andrews it was ordered that a Notice be published in the Chapel Hill News that application would be made to the present General Assembly for an ~~Change~~ <sup>Amendment</sup> to the Charter of the town of Chapel Hill.

On Motion of Mr. Andrews the police was directed to notify all dressing Clubs that if any further just complaint is made of their not delivering clothes promptly that their license will be reelected.

The Committee of the whole Board reported that the Hillsboro road should come into town by way of Columbia St.

On Motion of Mr. Andrew, the Tax Collector was directed to give N.Y. Passenger receipt for Seven rent to Jan 1st upon payment of the amount of One dollar per day. The following ordinance offered by Mr. Andrew was adopted:

12/18/1888

Be it enacted, that after the date of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person, or persons, to offer for sale within the Corporate limits of the town of Chapel Hill, any goods, wares, or merchandise of any description, by the aid of a Punch Board, or any drawing device, or automatic machine which does give for each purchase the same exact specific merchandise, and the same value. Any device which carries an element of chance, or offers a special prize shall be unlawful.

Each person, violating this Ordinance, shall be fined not less than five dollars for each offense. By order Town Alderman, in regular Session,
