 Jm. Chubb, the following ordinance was adopted:

THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL DO ENACT:-

1. That all persons, firms or corporations, acting as agents and salesmen for any person, firm or corporation dealing in clothing, shoes, and gents furnishing goods, who shall sell clothing, shoes, and gents furnishing goods by sample in the Town of Chapel Hill, shall before engaging in said business pay an annual license tax of Twenty Five Dollars.
2. That any person, firm or corporation who shall carry on any business for which license is required by Section "1" of this ordinance without first obtaining a license therefor shall be subject to a penalty of \$50.00.
