On motion of Dr. Wilson, the following taxes were levied for the year 1918:
For general purposes, 50¢ on each \$100.
Worth of property and \$1.50 on each poll,
and for school maintenance 33½¢ on
each \$100. worth of property and \$1.00 on
each poll in the school district, and
to pay interest on and create a sinking
fund to pay off the school bonds
25¢ on each \$100. worth of property
and 75¢ on each poll in the school
district.

On motion of Mr. Hagan, the fire dept
was allowed \$90.00 to pay expenses
of four delegates to State Convention
of the Firemen's Assn. at Wilmington
early in August.

On motion of Mr. Hagan the Mayor
was authorized to have old sewer and
sanitary books checked up.

The Board then adjourned.
