The Board of Aldermen of the Town of Chapel Hill Do Enact:

That the Mayor and the ^{Clerk} Secretary are hereby empowered
and authorized to advertise for sale on the 15th day of March,
1919, on the premises at one o'clock p. m., at public auction
for cash, a certain house and lot belonging to the Town of
Chapel Hill, situated on the East side of Henderson Street, and
being the property formerly purchased from the Orange County
Board of Education, the sale to be advertised in the Chapel Hill
News.

The Mayor and the Secretary are hereby authorized
and empowered to execute a deed to the purchaser in fee simple
on the payment of the purchase price.

The Board then Adjourned.

a salary of \$1.00 per day.
On Motion of Mr. Chas. J. S. Holmes
C.S. Mongon and M.C. S. Noble
were appointed a special board
to supervise and assist in
the care of the Negro Cemetery,
also the sum of \$25.00 was
appropriated for their use in
making improvements.
On Motion the St. Com. was in-
structed to grade off a short
hill in the west end of North St.
