Rickard were authorized to close contracts with Mr. Gurley for the installation of a heating system for the firehouse. On Motion of Dr. Pratt the following resolutions were adopted:

That no person shall be allowed to erect a building within thirty(30) feet of any side walk in the residential section of the Town of Chapel Hill, without special permission of the Board of Aldermen of said town.

That the property owners on North, Ransom and Patterson Streets may install sewer lines, under the supervision of the town engineer, and that the town will take over the same and pay the construction cost of same, without interest, as soon as there are enough users to pay 6% on said cost.

The Board then adjourned.

On Motion of Dr. Pratt, it was ordered that no merchandise shall be displayed on outside walls, and that no boxes, bags or other containers, or goods in any other shape ~~shall be allowed,~~ ~~be~~ ~~main~~ going in or out of any building shall remain on any side walk ~~&~~ street longer than twelve hours ~~day light,~~ and that no opening in any sidewalk to cellar shall be permitted.

On motion of Dr. Pratt the following ordinance was adopted:

That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to peddle any food or merchandise in the Town of Chapel Hill between the hours of 6:30 A.M. and 6:30 P.M.

On Motion a new limit was ordered placed on Franklin St. about midway way between The Peoples Room and the intersection of Columbia St.

The Board then adjourned to meet Monday, Nov. 7th.
