The Board of Aldermen of 3 P.M.
Mr. Chick presiding.
All members of the Board present
except M.W. Lashon.
On Motion of Dr. Pratt, the
Board of Health or Health Office
were authorized to quarantine
from school any one who
has any Contagious disease or
comes from any home or rooming
house where there is any
Contagious disease.
On Motion of Mr. Pratt Mayor
Rosen and Mr. Hisason were
authorized to negotiate with
Mr. Lawson for 10 ft. of his
lot to add to st.
On Motion of G.C. Ricard the
tentative budget presented
Oct. 25th, was adopted.

Alderman J.H. Pratt then introduced certain bond ordinances entitled, "AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL TO ISSUE \$12,000.00 OF CURB AND GUTTER BONDS" and "AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL TO ISSUE \$8,000.00 OF SEWER BONDS" and "AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL TO ISSUE \$6,000.00 OF FIRE DEPARTMENT BONDS" and "AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL TO ISSUE \$5,000.00 OF MUNICIPAL BUILDING BONDS" and "AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL TO ISSUE \$3,500.00 OF FUNDING BONDS".

The Town Treasurer then made and filed with the Clerk as required by law, a statement of debt of the Town of Chapel Hill.

THE ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL TO ISSUE \$12,000.00 OF CURB AND GUTTER BONDS was then brought up for consideration and upon motion of Alderman

J.H. Pratt seconded by Alderman G.C. Ricard was duly adopted, all of the Aldermen present voting in the affirmative therefor, to-wit: M. Chick
