Section 4. That for the purpose of said election, a new registration of the voters of said District is hereby ordered. The books for said new registration shall be kept open between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and sunset each day (Sunday excepted) from the 1st day of May, 1922, to the 20th day of May, 1922, both inclusive. On each Saturday during said registration period, the Registrar shall attend with his book at the polling place for the registration of voters.

Section 5. That for the purpose of said new registration and election, J. H. Raney is hereby appointed and designated Registrar, and R. A. Leffer and C. L. Wills judges. The polling place for said new registration and election is hereby designated as The Chapel Hill Graded School Building in said District.

Section 6. That a copy of this ordinance signed by the Mayor and Clerk and said Registrar shall be published in The News, as a notice of new registration not later than March 30th, 1922, and as notice of said election for thirty days beginning not later than April 27th, 1922.

Upon motion of Alderman J. H. Raney, seconded by Alderman R. A. Leffer, the following resolution was adopted, all the Aldermen present voting in the affirmative therefor, to-wit:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL.

Section 1. That that certain resolution adopted by the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Chapel Hill on the 8th day of March, 1922, authorizing the combining into one issue of \$12,000.00 of Crub and Gutter Bonds, \$8,000.00 of Sewer Bonds, \$6,000.00 of Fire Department Bonds, \$5,000.00 of Municipal Bonds, and authorizing the issue of said bonds as Public Improvement Bonds and fixing the form of said Public Improvement Bonds, be and the same is hereby amended by striking from the form of said bond, the second paragraph thereof, and inserting in lieu thereof, the following:

"This bond is one of thirty-one bonds of like date and amount, aggregating \$31,000, comprising a consolidated issue made up of four several bond issues authorized by four several ordinances, respectively, passed November 7, 1921, being an issue of \$12,000 bonds for constructing curbs and gutters, an issue of \$8,000 bonds for extending the sewerage system, an issue of \$6,000 bonds for purchasing fire-fighting vehicles, and an issue of \$5,000 bonds for building a municipal building, all within and for said Town; and this bond is issued under and pursuant to The Municipal Finance Act of North Carolina and the said ordinances and also a resolution duly passed".

Section 2. That except as herein amended, the said resolution is in all other respects, ratified and confirmed.

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Upon motion of Alderman J. H. Pratt seconded
by Alderman W. C. Riden, the following resolution
was adopted, all the Aldermen present voting in the affir-
mative therefor, to-wit: _____

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE
TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL.

Section 1. That that certain resolution adopted by
the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Chapel Hill on the
8th day of March, 1922, authorizing the issuance of \$3,500.00
of Funding Bonds and prescribing the form of said bonds, be
and the same is hereby amended by striking out the second
paragraph of said bond form and inserting in lieu thereof,
the following:

"This bond is one of a series of seven bonds
of like date, tenor, and amount except as to maturi-
ties aggregating the sum of \$3,500.00, and is issued
under and pursuant to The Municipal Finance Act and
an ordinance and resolution duly adopted by the Board
of Aldermen of said Town, authorizing the issuance of
\$3,500.00 of bonds for the purpose of funding and pay-
ing a like amount of valid subsisting indebtedness
of said Town (other than bonded indebtedness) created
before December 6th, 1921, for the necessary purposes
of said Town".

Section 2. That except as herein amended, the said
resolution is in all other respects, ratified and confirmed.

1922, at the purchase price of thirty five hundred and sixty one
Dollars (\$3561.00) and accrued interest on said bonds, being the high-
est bid received for said bonds, be and the same is hereby accepted.

Section 3. That the Mayor and Clerk are authorized, instructed, and
directed to deliver the said bonds to the said purchasers upon the receipt
of the purchase price thereof.
