An application was presented from Mr. R.L.Stroud for the Town to pay one-half the cost of a concrete side-walk in front of the Stroud Building on Franklin Street. On motion it was decided that the present ordinances in regard to the construction of sidewalks must not be changed until the end of the municipal year due to the lack of funds to carry on this work.

There being no further business the Board adjourned.
