The Board of Aldermen of the Town of Chapel Hill met at 7:45 P.M., Mayor Roberson presiding.

The Aldermen present were Messers. R.P.Andrews, M.W. Durham and H.W.Odum.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Upon motion duly passed the Town Business Mnager was authorized to make Tax Refunds without presenting each case to the Board of Aldermen.

Upon motion Alderman H.W.Odum seconded by Alderman M.W.Durham the following resolution was duly passed:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL:

Section 1. That all persons who have not paid their town taxes for 1922 and who owe sanitary tax or sewer rent for a period more than six months are hereby declared delinquents.

Section 2. That the Manager is hereby instructed to levy upon the property of all such delinquents.

Section 3. That in case the taxes are not paid after said levy, that the Manager is instructed to sell said property at public auction.

Section 4. That the names of all such delinquents be included in these records. Page 261. & 262.

Upon motion of Alderman H.W.Odum seconded by Alderman R.P.Andrews the Manager was instructed to investigate the Somers Unit System for the valuation of real estate for taxation, and to take the necessary steps for the installation of such a system in the Town of Chapel Hill.

The Board of aldermen adjourned at 10 P.M.
