The Board of Aldermen met at 9 P.M., Mayor Roberson presiding.

The Aldermen present were Messrs. R.P. Andrews, G.M. Braune, D.D. Carroll, J.M. Cheek and H.A. Whitfield.

The minutes of the last meeting of the Board of Aldermen were read and approved.

The Mayor and the newly elected members of the Board of Aldermen took the oath of office. See pages 266, 267 & 268.

Upon motion of Alderman H.A. Whitfield seconded by Alderman D.D. Carroll the following resolution was passed:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL:

Section 1. That the Manager ~~id~~ hereby instructed to have a survey made of the Public Cemetery.

Section 2. That the Manager institute a system of burial permits or deeds to show the ownership of the Cemetery lots.

Section 3. That the Mnager obtain from the University of North Carolina a statement or deed showing that the Town of Chapel Hill really owns the Cemetery.

Upon motion the request to open up a street from Franklin Street to Rosemary Street west of the Delta Tau Delta property was reffered to the Street Committee.

Upon motion the request to put drain pipe in the ditch on the south side of Franklin Street west of McCauley Street was referred to the Street Committee.

Upon motion of Alderman D.D. Carroll seconded by Alderman R.P. Andrews the Finance Committee and the Manager were instructed to prepare a tentative list of the values of all the real estate and to present same to the County Board of Assessors.

Section 2. That Edward M. Knox is hereby elected to fill this position for a period of one year beginning June 1, 1923.

Section 3. That the salary of this position shall be \$2400.00 per year.

Section 4. That the title of this position shall be "Town Business Manager".
