shall be marked on the right at an angle of 45 degrees with the curb and against the curb.

Upon motion of Alderman R.P.Andrews seconded by Alderman J.M.Cheek the Sanitary Ordinances were amended so as to require the use of paper drinking cups at all soda fountains. (This revives Section 22 of the Sanitary Ordinances.)

Upon motion of Alderman R.P.Andrews seconded by Alderman J.M.Cheek the following resolution was duly passed:

Section 1. That the Budget of the Town of Chapel Hill for the year 1923-24 as submitted by the Manager be approved and placed on file in his office.

Section 2. That notice be given of a public hearing to be held in the Mayor's Office on Monday, June 18th at 5 P.M. before the final adoption of said budget,

Section 1. That the Emergency Automobile Regulation

Section 2. That Section 6 of the Automobile Regulations be amended to read as follows:

All automobiles in the business district shall be parked on the right at an angle of 45 degrees with the curb and against the curb. Automobiles shall be considered as parked when left by the drivers.
