Upon motion of Alderman Hogan, seconded by Alderman Burch, it was moved that Section #154 of Schedule "B", License and Privilege Taxes from the Public Laws of North Carolina for 1929 be adopted, insofar as they apply to Chapel Hill, and that the same be considered a part of the License and Privilege Tax Ordinance of Chapel Hill. All the aldermen present voted in the affirmative therefor.

Section No.154 deals with emigrants and with employment agents.
