

Minutes of the Board of Aldermen, Town of Chapel Hill, January 11, 1933.

Book 6, Page 182

The regular Meeting of the Board of Aldermen was held in the Town Office at 8 o'clock P. M., January 11, 1933, with Mayor Council presiding and the following Aldermen present: Messrs. Thompson, Eubanks, Dobbins and Burch; Town Attorney Sawyer was also present.

The minutes of the Meeting held December 14, were read and approved by the Board.

The following subjects were brought up and handled as indicated:

Subject: Auto License and Dog Tags:

The Town Manager stated that Mr. Hogan had talked with him in regard to getting Mr. Whitefield, who had been recommended to him as being in need of work, to collect the Auto and Dog License on a commission basis. He stated that Mr. Hogan had asked him to take it up with the Board and see if the Board would deem it wise to get him to collect the Licenses. Motion was made by Alderman Burch and seconded by Mr. Dobbins and passed by the Board that the question of Auto and Dog License be tabled until the next meeting. In the meantime every effort should be made to collect all possible.

Subject: Privilege License.

On motion of Alderman Dobbins seconded by Mr. Burch and passed by the Board, it was moved that the Board give the people owing Privilege License ten more days in which to pay the License before any action be taken.

Subject: Fire Commissioner's Report.

Mr. Burch, Fire Commissioner, reported to the Board that he and the Town Manager had met with some of the volunteer firemen in regard to the appointment of a Chief. Motion was made by Mr. Burch and seconded by Alderman Dobbins that the Board appoint Mr. P. R. Perry as Fire Chief and Mr. E. L. Whitehurst as assistant Fire Chief, provided that Mr. Caldwell, Town Manager and Alderman Burch be instructed to get up all regulations governing the Fire Department.

Subject: Petition for Selling Sandwiches.

Attorney Sawyer ask that the Town Manager write Mr. Phipps and tell him that the Board thinks the present law sufficient to cover the sale of sandwiches.

Subject: Sanitary Conditions Surrounding the Business Houses.

Motion was made by Alderman Eubanks seconded by Mr. Dobbins and passed by the Board that the Town Manager be authorized to get the Chief of Police to make weekly inspections of the Business Houses and make reports to the Town Manager of the conditions.

Subject: Jack Lipman's Bond.

Motion was made by Alderman Burch seconded by Mr. Thompson and passed by the Board that the \$2,000.00 Bond given Jack Lipman while selling bankrupt stock be released.

There being no further business, the Meeting of the Board of Aldermen adjourned.
