

Minutes of the Meeting of the Board of Aldermen, Town of Chapel Hill,
November 17, 1933.

Book 6, Page 256.

There was a call Meeting of the Board of Aldermen held in the Town Office at 7:30 P. M., o'clock, November 17, 1933. The Mayor and all the Aldermen were present.

The purpose of this meeting was to decide on the method of co-operating with the Federal Government through the Relief Agency at Raleigh in the matter of unemployment, which is handled under the direction of George Lawrence, Director. Motion was made by Alderman Hogan, seconded by Alderman Connor that the board of Aldermen co-operate with the Relief Organization in whatever projects that are to be decided upon, and the further motion which was made by Alderman Connor and seconded by Alderman Eubanks that a committee consisting of the Mayor, City Manager, P. L. Burch, B. S. Thompson and A. R. Hollett be named, which committee was to handle all details of dredging the channel below the sewer plant and whatever other necessary measures to be adopted to correct the bad situation there. This committee to have authority to act in all matters pertaining to the unemployment situation in regard to projects and co-operating with the work of the Welfare Director for Orange County, Mr. George Lawrence, together with whatever other organization that might be originated to assist him in carrying out the work.

There being no further business, the Board of Alderman adjourned.
