There was a called meeting of the Board of Aldermen, held at the Bank of Chapel Hill, February 28, at 7:30 P. M. The following Aldermen were present: C. L. Eubanks, M. E. Hogan, J. T. Dobbins, P. L. Burch and B. S. Thompson. In the absence of the Mayor, Alderman Eubanks acted in that capacity.

This meeting was called to pass a certain Ordinance as to parking on Pittsboro road from the University Railroad underpass to the Southern Limits of the Town of Chapel Hill, pursuant to the advice of the State Highway Commission that this Ordinance must be passed before the widening of the North Carolina Project No. 4610 by the Federal Government could be done. This Ordinance was passed in the affirmative on motion of Alderman P. L. Burch and seconded by Alderman B. S. Thompson and is herewith held as a part of the minutes of this meeting.

It was requested that 4 copies of this ordinance be forwarded to the State Highway Department, which is being done.

It was further necessary to pass certain resolutions with reference to the above mentioned project as follows:

- 1. Resolution by City Council.
- 2. Agreement as to maintenance.
- 3. Agreement as to underground structures and right-of-way.

This resolution was passed by the Board in the affirmative on motion of Alderman M. E. Hogan, and seconded by Alderman J. T. Dobbins. A copy of the resolution, as well as copies of the two above mentioned agreements, are herewith included as a part of these minutes, all of which are self explanatory.

There being no further business, the meeting of the Board of Aldermen adjourned.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN, TOWN OF

CHAPEL HILL,-

Section 1, That it shall be unlawful for any person to park an automobile on the East side of Pittsboro Road from the State University Railroad underpass to the Southern Limits of the Town of Chapel Hill.

Section 2. Any person violating the terms of this ordinance shall be fined \$5.00.
