Minutes of the Meeting of the Board of Aldermen, May 3, 1935.

There was a called meeting of the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Chapel Hill held at the Bank of Chapel Hill at 8:30 P. M., May 3, 1935. Mayor J. M. Foushee presided and the following Aldermen were present: Mr. J. T. Dobbins, B. S. Thompson, C. L. Eubanks and M. E. Hogan.

The purpose of this meeting was to appoint a judge of the election to be held May 7, in place of Mr. C. P. Hinshaw, who had announced his candidacy for Judge of Recorder's Court. On motion of Mr. M. E. Hogan, seconded by Mr. C. L. Eubanks, Mr. V. A. Hill was appointed to this place, and agreed to serve upon being called over the phone.

Attention was called to the act of one of the candidates who endeavored to ascertain if all the candidates were properly filed with the Town Clerk. The candidate in question evidently thought, in fact so stated, that some of the candidates were not properly filed. The Town Manager stated that this was not the case, as according to his own knowledge, all candidates were properly filed with the Town Clerk as required by law.

There being no further business, the Meeting of the Board of Aldermen adjourned.
