The regular meeting of the Board of Aldermen was held in the Town Hall at 8 o'clock P. M., July 10, 1935. Mayor J. M. Foushee presided and the following Aldermen were present: Messrs. J. T. Dobbins, C. L. Eubanks and R. J. M. Hobbs. Town Attorney, B. D. Sawyer, also was present.

The following subjects were brought up and handled as indicated:

Minutes of the regular meeting held June 12, were readn and approved.

Subject: Conduct of negro race in Chapel Hill.

Walter Hackney, Charlie Craig and one other negro man representing the colored Civic Club of Chapel Hill, came before the board in behalf of the Civic Club in regard to the conduct and morals of the negroes in Chapel Hill. The board decided that they should take it up with the City Manager and he would in turn instruct the police Department to give them assistance.

Subject: White Way Standards on East Franklin Street.

The City Manager stated that he had consulted the University Consolidated Service Plants in regard to the cost of erecting the White Way Standards, and they had said it would cost approximately \$225.00 for them to complete the line but if relief labor were used the cost would be less. Motion was made by Alderman Dobbins, seconded by Alderman Hobbs and passed by the Board that since the City Manager does not feel that the Town has the money to put in this work, that the matter be deferred till a later date.

Subject: Privilege License Ordinance.

The City Manager read the Ordinance as amended by him and Alderman Eubanks. Motion was made by Alderman Eubanks, seconded by Alderman Dobbins and passed by the board that the Ordinance with the changes as read by the City Manager be adopted for 1935-36. A copy of this ordinance is herewith attached as part of these minutes.

There being no further business, the Meeting of the $^{\rm B}$ oard of $^{\rm A}$ ldermen adjourned.
