Thompson, Auditor be adopted for the year 1935-36, a copy of which is herewith attached as part of these minutes. At this time Mayor Pro-tem read the request from the school board asking the town to levy a tax rate of 35¢ for the school.

Motion was made by Alderman Hobbs, seconded by Alderman Wettach and passed by the board that the tax rate for the town be set as follows:
