

MINUTES OF THE CALL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF  
CHAPEL HILL, TUESDAY FEBRUARY 2, 1937 AT 8:00 P. M.

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A call meeting of the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Chapel Hill was held in the Town Office Tuesday February 2, 1937, at 8:00 P. M. Mayor J. M. Foushee presided and the following Aldermen were present: R. J. M. Hobbs, J. T. Dobbins, P. L. Burch, M. L. Thompson, R. H. Wettach, and C. L. Eubanks. City Engineer, A. R. Hollett, was also present.

The purpose of the meeting was to let the contract for the Incinerator plant. The Nye Odorless<sup>INCINERATOR</sup> Company submitted the low bid, but with this bid there was a Treasurer's Check instead of the specified Certified Check. On the motion of Alderman Thompson, seconded by Alderman Dobbins, the Board voted unanimously to accept the Treasurer's Check.

Mr. Brown, representative of the Nye Odorless<sup>INCINERATOR</sup> Company, was present, and on the request of the Mayor, gave an outline of the advantages of the unit which his company has for sale. Mr. Hollett presented a detail description of the proposed construction, and also brought out the requirements of the guarantee as set forth in the contract. On the motion of Alderman Wettach, seconded by Alderman Burch, the contract was let to the Nye Odorless<sup>INCINERATOR</sup> Company on the unanimous vote of the Board of Aldermen.

The Board approved the motion made by Alderman Hobbs, seconded by Alderman Dobbins, that Alderman Thompson and Mayor Foushee be instructed to work with a committee representing the Chapel Hill Graded School Board of Trustees on the matter of street assessments and garbage fees due to the Town.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
