The purpose of the meeting was to act upon the recommendation of the Zoning Committee to change a portion of W. Rosemary Street from Residence Zone B to Business Zone 2.

Upon motion of Alderman Burch, seconded by Alderman Lanier, all members present voting in the affirmative the following resolution was adopted:

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Chapel Hill unanimously approve the recommendation of the Zoning Committee to change the South Side of West Rosemary Street, between Church Street and the alley leading to Ogburn Furniture Company, from Residence Zone "B" to Business Zone "2", as outlined in a petition submitted by the property owners on said street, said petition appearing in Book 7, Page 320 of the minutes of the Board of Aldermen.
