A special meeting was held Thursday, July 10th for the purpose of discussing the proposed budget for the fiscal year 1947-48.

Mayor Madry presided over the meeting and all members were present except Mr. Davis.

The matter of an appropriation for an Assistant Tax Collector was again discussed and Mr. Patterson made a motion, seconded by Mr. Fitch, Mr. W. P. Jordan be reinstated as Assistant Tax collector at a salary of \$50.00 per month as long as the Board feels that the service is justified and provided that he makes a written report monthly for presentation to the Board at its regular meetings. Voting in the affirmative were Messrs. Patterson, Burch, Fitch and Lanier.

Mr. Patterson moved that the \$25.00 for Chairty be eliminated from the Budget. Seconded by Mr. Burch, and unanimously passed.

Considerable discussion was given to the matter of appropriation for the labor and truck force. Other proposed appropriations were discussed at length. The adoption of the budget was deferred until a later date.

The meeting adjourned.
