BOARD OF ALDERMEN TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL  
JUNE 11, 1948

A called meeting of the Board of Aldermen was held June 11, 1948 at 2:30 P.M. This meeting was called by Mayor Madry to receive bids on the sewerage improvements project. All Board members were present.
