Special Meeting Board of Alderman--Chapel Hill, N. C. November 6, 1951

A special meeting of the Board of Alderman was held in the Town Hall on November 6, 1951 at 8~P.M.

Present were Mayor Lanier, Aldermen Fowler, Fitch, Burch, and Putnam; Town Manager Rose and Town Attorney Hinshaw.

Alderman Cornwell and Davis were out of town and Alderman Fitch was in an important meeting; therefore, a quorum not being present, the Board held an informal discussion until Alderman Fitch joined the group at 9 P.M. Mr. Fitch arrived and the Board then went into formal session. The Mayor stated the order of business for this special meeting as announced in his November 5, 1951 Notice to the Board of Alderman.
