Minutes Regular Meeting  
Board of Aldermen--Chapel Hill, N. C.  
July 13, 1953

The regular meeting of the Board of Aldermen was held in the Town Hall on July 13, 1953 at 8:00 o'clock p.m.

Present were Mayor Lanier, Aldermen Davis, Burch, Robinson, Cornwell and Putnam, Town Auditor Peacock, Town Engineer Gove, and Town Manager Rose.

The minutes for the regular meeting of June 29, 1953 were approved as read and amended.

Mr. Lanier introduced Mr. Ma'nopo who is visiting Chapel Hill from Indonesia. Mr. Cleaveland, who came with Ma'nopo, gave a short talk on Indonesia and told of Mr. Ma'nopo's purpose for visiting the United States.

Mr. Rose read a letter from Mr. M. J. Dawson, requesting that a sewer line be installed on Valley Drive. After considerable discussion Mr. Burch moved that the Town Manager be authorized to call for bids for the installation of the sewer line (for Mr. Dawson), and for approximately 200 feet on Westwood Drive, from the Fuller Corner - East. Mr. Putnam seconded his motion and it was passed unanimously.

The Clerk of Court and Police reports were presented to the Board.

Mr. Peacock gave the Auditor's report for the month of June.

Mr. Rose presented the Health Department report for the month of June.

Mr. Rose read the Fire Department report from June 25th through May 12.

The matter of electing a Prosecuting Attorney was brought up. Mr. Rose read a letter of application from Mr. Emery Denny, Jr. Action on the matter was deferred until the next meeting.

Mr. Rose recommended Mr. P. R. Perry for Fire Chief for the fiscal year 1953-1954. Mr. Cornwell moved that Mr. Perry be appointed. Mr. Putnam seconded his motion and it was passed unanimously.

Mr. Rose brought up the matter of refunding \$36.00 sewer rent for the years 1950, 1951 and 1952, to Mr. T. R. Pendergraft. Mr. Burch moved that Mr. Pendergraft be reimbursed for erroneous charges for 1950-1952 sewer rent. Mr. Davis seconded his motion and it was passed unanimously.

Mr. Rose brought up the matter of surfacing or resurfacing the following streets under the 1953 Powell Bill Fund: Cameron Avenue, Lindsay Street, McDade Street, Henderson Street, Hill and Jones Streets, Dogwood Drive, Woodland Avenue, and Westwood. After considerable discussion Mr. Cornwell moved that the Town Manager be authorized to call for bids for surfacing and resurfacing the following streets: Cameron Avenue, Lindsay Street, McDade Street, Henderson Street, Hill and Jones Streets. Mr. Putnam seconded his motion and it was passed unanimously.

Mr. Rose brought up the matter of issuing \$60,000 in bonds for curb and gutter. The Board members signed an application to the North Carolina Local Government Commission for approval of the issue.

Mr. Gove reported that surveys for curb and gutter will be completed by the third week in August.

The matter of curb and gutter for Carolina Avenue was discussed. Mr. Burch moved that the Town Manager and Town Engineer get a contractor for the curb and gutter project. Mr. Putnam seconded his motion and it was passed unanimously.

Mr. Putnam reported that the Recreation Committee would like to have the work done on the grounds at the Community Center. Mr. Burch moved that the Town Manager be authorized to have the work done. Mr. Cornwell seconded his motion and it was passed unanimously.

Mr. Burch brought up the matter of a drainage problem on Cobb Terrace. Mr. Burch moved that Mr. Rose be authorized to have a drain pipe put in. Mr. Cornwell seconded his motion and it was passed unanimously.

Mr. Robinson brought up the matter of having brush removed from traffic corners. Mr. Robinson moved that Mr. Rose be authorized to have brush cleared. Mr. Putnam seconded his motion and it was passed unanimously.

Mr. Burch brought up the matter of rooming houses not having fire escapes and asked for a ruling on what constitutes a rooming house. The matter was turned over to Town Attorney LeGrand.

Upon motion by Mr. Davis, seconded by Mr. Putnam and unanimous consent, the meeting was adjourned at 9:50 P. M. o'clock.

After hearing the minutes for the regular meeting of July 13, 1953, read as amended on motion made by Alderman Robinson, seconded by Alderman Putnam, the minutes were approved by vote of the Board of Aldermen this the 10th day of August, 1953.
