Present; Mayor Lanier, Aldermen Burch, Cornwell, Putnam and Robinson, Town Manager Rose and John R. Gove, Engineer.

Mayor Lanier reported on a conference between the University, Town and North Carolina State Highway Commission representatives on the matter of the State maintaining Cameron Avenue and South Graham Street.

The Town Manager reported on the bid opening for street work held on September 3rd. Two bids were received; William Muirhead Construction Company bid at a unit price of \$10.00 per ton for asphalt surfacing and Nello L. Teer Company bid at \$7.00 per ton. This large difference in price resulted in considerable discussion. Finally, Alderman Cornwell made the following motion, seconded by Alderman Robinson: That the contract be awarded to Nello L. Teer Company at the unit price called for in the bid, provided that a competent inspector be placed at Teer's asphalt plant at all times while the work in Chapel Hill is in progress. The motion was passed.

Town Manager Rose recommended the appointment of Eugene Barber Cozart, 204 Roxboro Street, Durham, North Carolina for vacancy in the Police Department for a trial period of 90 days, at \$190.00 per month. The recommendation was approved. Perdupula was approved.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 9:00 P. M.
