RETURN OF REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN THE TOWN OF
CHAPEL HILL, NORTH CAROLINA, ON THE 3RD DAY OF MAY, 1955.

We, the undersigned R. B. VAUGHAN, MRS. IRENE SCROGGS and MRS. J. F. CRAWFORD, being the Registrar and Judges of Election appointed to hold the regular municipal election in the Town of Chapel Hill, in the State of North Carolina, on the 3rd day of May, 1955, DO HEREBY CERTIFY as follows:

1. The polls for said election were opened at the Fire Department, Town Hall, Northwest corner Columbia & Rosemary Streets in the Town of Chapel Hill on the 3rd day of May, 1955, at the hour of 6:30 o'clock, A.M. (Eastern Standard Time) and were continuously kept open at said place until the hour of 6:30 o'clock, P.M. (Eastern Standard Time) on said day.
2. Only persons who had been duly registered were permitted to vote at said election. The total number of voters who were registered and qualified to vote at said election was 7368.
3. All persons voting at said election were required to use ballots in the form prescribed by the resolution adopted by the Board of Aldermen of said Town on March 28, 1955, and bearing the facsimile signature of MARY LOVEJOY, Town Clerk.
4. The total number of votes cast for Proposition No. 1 set forth in said ballots was 510. The total number of votes cast against said Proposition was 79.
5. The total number of votes cast for Proposition No. 2 set forth in said ballots was 473. The total number of votes cast against said Proposition was 83.
6. The total number of votes cast for Proposition No. 3 set forth in said ballots was 440. The total number of votes cast against said Proposition was 131.
7. The total number of votes cast for Proposition No. 4 set forth in said ballots was 452. The total number of votes cast against said Proposition was 104.
8. The total number of votes cast for Proposition No. 5 set forth in said ballots was 495. The total number of votes cast against said Proposition was 77.
9. The total number of votes cast for Proposition No. 6 set forth in said ballots was 497. The total number of votes cast against said Proposition was 66.
