

## MINUTES

Board of Aldermen

Town of Chapel Hill, N. C.

The Board of Aldermen met at a Special Meeting held in the Town Hall at 4:00 P.M., o'clock, June 20, 1957, with the following present: Mayor Cornwell: Aldermen Davis, Wager, Strowd, Robinson, Walters and Giduz. Town Manager Rose.

Mayor Cornwell stated that the purpose of the meeting was to consider the Proposed Budget for the year 1957-58. Alderman Wager, chairman of the Finance Committee explained the wage scales and suggested changes.

Alderman Wager moved the adoption of the Scale of Pay for the Police and Fire Department, as submitted and examined, seconded by Alderman Giduz, and unanimously adopted. Effective July 1, 1957.

After some changes had been made in the budget as submitted, Alderman Walters moved the adoption of the 1957-58 Tentative Budget, seconded by Alderman Robinson, and unanimously adopted. Under this budget the Tax Rate will remain as \$0.95 per \$100.00 valuation.

Alderman Giduz moved that the Tentative Budget be tabled according to law, for the following 20 days, seconded by Alderman Wager, and passed.

Re: M. J. Dawson. The Board of Aldermen instructed Town Manager Rose to authorize Town Attorney LeGrand to take legal action to enjoin the construction and occupancy of a multiple family dwelling unit located on the South Side of Rosemary Street which is in violation of the Zoning Ordinance.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:56 P.M., o'clock.
