## Special Meeting Board of Aldermen--Chapel Hill, N. C. November 3, 1952

A special meeting of the Board of Aldermen was held in the Town Hall on November 3, 1952 at 7 p.m. o'clock.

Present were Mayor Lanier, Aldermen Fowler, Fitch, Burch, Cornwell, and Futnam, and Town Manager Rose.

Mr. Lanier stated that the purpose of this meeting was to hear the recommendation of the Town Manager after his study and investigation of a garbage truck and a fire truck.

Mr. Rose said that, on the basis of his investigation of fire trucks, it would be most favorable to the Town of Chapel Hill to accept the bid of the American-La-France Foamite Corporation at \$16,180.00. Therefore, the Town Manager recommended the purchase of the American-La-France Foamite Corporation fire truck and the Mickey Packer garbage body with a 2 ton Chevrolet chassis and one Mickey Packer body to go on the present garbage chassis at the prices set forth below.

After much discussion, Mr. Fowler moved that, on the basis of reports made by the Town Manager, the Oren-Roanoke Corporation bid be dropped from further consideration. His motion was seconded by Mr. Cornwell and passed unanimously.

Mr. Putnam moved that the Town buy an American-La-France Foamite Corporation fire truck. This motion was seconded by Mr. Fitch and unanimously passed.

Mr. Cornwell moved that the Town buy a Mickey Packer garbage truck and a new body as outlined. His motion was seconded by Mr. Burch and unanimously passed.
