

MINUTES OF A CONTINUATION OF THE JANUARY 11, 1988 REGULAR MEETING, AND ITS CONTINUATION ON JANUARY 13, 1988 OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL, MUNICIPAL BUILDING, MONDAY, JANUARY 25, 1988 7:30 P.M.

Mayor Jonathan B. Howes called the meeting to order. Council Members present were:

Council Members Andresen and Pasquini arrived late. Council Member Werner was absent. Also present were Town Manager David R. Taylor, Assistant Town Manager Sonna Loewenthal and Town Attorney Ralph Karpinos.

Old Lystra Subdivision

Mayor Howes asked the Town Attorney for a report on the litigation regarding Old Lystra Subdivision.

Town Attorney Ralph Karpinos stated that on January 13 the Council had recessed the meeting until this evening. He said the Town had filed a motion with the court in order to seek a determination as to whether the Town was required to act to approve the Old Lystra Subdivision as directed by the Court Order of December 31, 1987. He said the Town had asked the Court for a determination that the appeal which was entered by the Town on January 11, 1988 made further action by the Council unnecessary until the appeal was heard in the Appellate Courts. Mr. Karpinos stated that a hearing was held on the motion this morning and the Judge ruled that further action by the Council to approve the subdivision pending the appeal was not necessary. He said this meant no action was required of the Council on the subdivision at this time.

COUNCIL MEMBER HERZENBERG MOVED, SECONDED BY COUNCIL MEMBER WALLACE TO ADJOURN THE MEETING. THE MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY, (8-0).
